• **Proverbs** **Our Witness to Truth (14:25)**

A truthful witness saves lives,
but a false witness is deceitful.

• **Ecclesiastes** **The Forgotten Wise Man (9:15)**

Now there lived in that city a man poor but wise, and he saved the city by his wisdom. But nobody remembered that poor man.

• **Song** **Outstanding among 10,000 (5:10)**

My beloved is radiant and ruddy,
outstanding among ten thousand

• **Isaiah** **Intercession for our Transgression (53:12)**

I suggest reading all of Isaiah Chapter 53

Therefore I will give him a portion among the great,
and he will divide the spoils with the strong,
because he poured out his life unto death,
and was numbered with the transgressors.
For he bore the sin of many,
and made intercession for the transgressors.

• **Jeremiah** **Our Righteousness (23:6)**

In his days Judah will be saved
and Israel will live in safety.
This is the name by which he will be called:
The LORD Our Righteousness.

• **Lamentations** **Man of Sorrow (1:12)**

“Is it nothing to you, all you who pass by?
Look around and see.
Is any suffering like my suffering
that was inflicted on me,
that the LORD brought on me
in the day of his fierce anger?”

- Read all of Isaiah 53. How does this describe Jesus?
