This summer we are taking a journey through all 66 books of the Bible to find Christ in all scriptures.

I encourage you to join us by reading through the verses selected from each book in order and come to know Christ as God's eternal plan of hope. In your small group, come together and discuss what you are learning about Jesus Christ and God's plan.

- **Ezekiel Restorer of God's Glory (43:4)**

The glory of the LORD entered the temple through the gate facing east

How does this passage relate to Christ?

- **Daniel The Son of God (3:24-25)**

Then King Nebuchadnezzar was astonished; and he rose in haste and spoke, saying to his counselors, "Did we not cast three men bound into the midst of the fire?"

They answered and said to the king, "True, O king."

"Look!" he answered, "I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire; and they are not hurt, and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God."

How does this passage relate to Christ?

- **Hosea Healer of Backslider (6:1)**

Come, and let us return to the LORD;

For He has torn, but He will heal us;

He has stricken, but He will bind us up.

What have you discovered this week about Jesus from these Old Testament books?

- **Joel The Bridegroom of the People (2:16)**

Gather the people,

Sanctify the congregation,

Assemble the elders,

Gather the children and nursing babes;

Let the bridegroom go out from his chamber,

And the bride from her dressing room.

How does this passage relate to Christ?

- **Amos New Wine (9:13)**

"The days are coming," declares the LORD, "when the reaper will be overtaken by the plowman and the planter by the one treading grapes. New wine will drip from the mountains and flow from all the hills.

How does this passage relate to Christ?

- **Obadiah Savior (1:17)**

But on Mount Zion will be deliverance;

it will be holy, and Jacob will possess his inheritance.

How does this passage relate to Christ?

Group Discussion Questions:

- Review Daniel 3;24-25 again. See in the last words, "Son of God". It seems from this passage that Jesus actually appeared in the fire and saved God's loyal men. How did Jesus repeat that process on the cross?
- Joel teaches of the bridegroom and his bride. Jesus is the bridegroom and we are his bride (See Revelation 19:7, 21:2, 21:9). God made marriage as a replica of His love relationship with us. What does this teach you about your relationship with Jesus?
- What should that tell you about your commitment to Jesus?
