• **Zechariah The Righteous Branch (3:8)**

“Listen, High Priest Joshua, you and your associates seated before you, who are men symbolic of things to come: I am going to bring my servant, the Branch.

How does this passage relate to Christ?

• **Malachi The Sun Of Righteousness (4:2)**

But for you who revere my name, the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its rays. And you will go out and frolic like well-fed calves.

How does this passage relate to Christ?

• **Matthew King of Jews (2:2)**

(Magi) asked, “Where is the one who has been born king of the Jews? We saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him.”

• **Mark The Messiah (14:61-62)**

Again the high priest asked him, “Are you the Messiah, the Son of the Blessed One?” “I am,” said Jesus. “And you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Mighty One and coming on the clouds of heaven.”

What does this passage teach you about Christ?

- **Luke Son of Man (19:10)**
“For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.”

- **John The Word of God (1:1)**
In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
